There is insufficient evidence to determine if or how the programme continues to meet the standards of education and training. Therefore, a visit is recommended to gather more evidence and if required place conditions on ongoing approval of the programme.

Reasons

The Panel is satisfied with the visitors' recommendation that the education provider must demonstrate how all of the standards of education and training (SETs) continue to be met before ongoing approval of the programme can be confirmed. It is recommended that a visit take place within two to three months.
